(We have printed here below an excerpt from a book written by the postulator for the Cause of Mother Mariana de Jesus Torres, Mgr. Dr. Luis E. Cadena y Almeida --now gone to his eternal reward -RIP . The book is entitled “Madera para Esculpir la Imagen de una Santa” ChapterXI pg132-133. We translated this as we wished to share what he wrote about Mother Mariana’s last Christmas with her sisters as this is a wonderful example of the true meaning of Christmas which has been lost in our present day. (Her words are also printed on the holy card we have sent to you enclosed in this newsletter). She died, three weeks later, on January 16, 1635, at the age of 72.)

Mother Mariana's Last Christmas on Earth

“At this moment, the path to her true Mother country [Heaven] was short for the Mother Mariana ... And naturally, the closer to the end [of her life], the more impetuously fervent was the fire of her love for God. Her heart though physically depressed and shaken was spiritually an ember of love of God and of the Blessed Mother and her neighbor. In every gesture, every word, every movement and every manner could be observed a total overflowing of charity, tenderness and kindness; her prayers more vigorous, her counsel more constant, her vigilance more strict, her observance more exemplary.

The human creature transformed into that of one angelic. The eyes of her nuns were focused on her; counting the joyful minutes that they had yet of her presence; and, as they were diminished, their grief welled up in their throats and yet, so as to maintain blessed harmony, held there until their grief was converted into uncontrollable weeping.

Mother's [Mariana] blue eyes, overcome with gratitude for so much love, shown like rivers of hope ...and with a sweet sounding voice she said:

'My Daughters so beloved, do not fear. Although the parched oak of my body will be separated from you, the flame of my spirit will be your constant company. Let us take advantage of these days of my fleeting presence to be united together in the love of God, in the generous oblation of our lives that we give to Him and prepare our hearts to receive to the Infant Jesus. Already we know that our community must be dressed in our best garments to celebrate the Birth of the Lord, adorning the manger of Bethlehem with the light of virtues, with the straw of mortification, with the delicate purity of the angels, with the joy of the shepherds and with the delight of Mary and Joseph - each one of us in humility, desiring to improve ourselves through the faithful fulfillment of the Divine Will.'

By Her words and her example, she made that Christmas of 1634 with the novena and the Feast Day unforgettable. In the novena, how much enthusiasm, fervor, mortifications, pleas, canticles and effusions of sanctity! And on the Feast [of Christmas], how much heavenly joy overflowing with divine happiness! New habits were distributed to the whole community. A Christmas of splendor and beauty! Many times, she would take her harp upon her lap to strum with great skill and a melodious voice, taking the principal part in the song, perhaps much like the swans that sweeten their voice when they have a presentiment of their death, or, better yet, like those rehearsing to unite their rhythmic pitch of their arpeggios to the choir of the angels.”

Testimonials:

Our Lady of Quito watching over her children... Spring 2006

Five years ago in 2001 my loving husband Vern retired, and during the Lenten Season of that year he decided to memorize the Seven Sorrows of Our Blessed Mother. Sharing with me this beautiful devotion, we decided to add it to our evening prayers from that time on.

January of this year, Vern and I ventured to Quito Ecuador with 21 other folks on a Religious Pilgrimage. Our main focus was to visit Our Lady of Good Success, but as well to visit the most revered and miraculous picture of “La Dolorosa” or in English, Our Lady of Sorrows (aka: Our Lady of Quito). At that time we were able to venerate the picture, as well as touch our Rosaries, scapulars and medals to the sacred image. This most precious image is housed in the Jesuit College of San Gabriel.

On January 20th, the first day of our Pilgrimage, we were able to participate in a “Rosary at Dawn” in honor of The La Dolorosa, through the streets of Old Colonial Quito. Due to the love and devotion that the local Catholics have for Our Sorrowful Mother, this Rosary will forever be one of the fondest we ever prayed. The

“Rosary at Dawn” is prayed every month on the 20th in honor of The La Dolorosa. (For on April 20th 1906 Our Lady opened and closed her eyes for more than twenty minutes before the amazed gaze of forty students of the College of San Gabriel.)

March 20th, started as any other Monday in Lent, however with a number of exceptions...it is the First day of Spring and Vern’s younger brother’s birthday. And in Quito the “Rosary at Dawn” had already taken place. That evening Vern and I were hosting our local square dance beginner’s class at our home. The 2nd dance was about half over when Vern commented that he was going to sit down for a while.

After the completion of the dance Vern waved me over to his side, and told me; “I think I am trying to have a Heart Attack....”

As Our Blessed Mother ALWAYS provides...one of our dear friends who was in attendance is a retired RN of better than 35 years! John knew just what to do; “....give him an aspirin, and let’s get to the hospital!” While the Doctors and staff were working on Vern, Johns’ support, assurances and Traditional Catholic strength kept me “all in one piece”. As the minutes wore into hours, it became evident that Vern had experienced an “event” and not a heart attack. Thanks to the warning Our Blessed Mother had provided, the Doctors would have enough time to do the appropriate tests to determine the correct method of repairing his heart.

After the tests were run and read, it was decided that open heart triple by/pass surgery would be the best method of repair; the surgeon had the first slot open on the morning of Friday the 24th.

As it happened the 24th was the Feast of Archangel St. Gabriel, one of the Pilgrims had offered to organize a community Rosary to be said in the Hospital Chapel during the time when Vern was to be in surgery. We were still in prayer when it was reported by the head operating nurse that the Doctor had “just cracked open his chest”. And once again Our Lady provided....our Assistant Parish Priest had offered to lead the Rosary. Upon his arrival, he unpacked and placed next to the Crucifix, for all to meditate upon, the picture of Our Lady of Sorrows.....Father had no way of knowing that Vern had a very special devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows, and why he chose to bring THAT picture...only Our Lady knows!

In counting our many blessings....our son Dean has been a fisherman in Alaska for the past 17 years, he returns home every spring for a few weeks. He came home this year the first week of March.....just 2 weeks before his dads “event”. In 17 years, he has NEVER been home this early from fishing.

Our friend and tour director in Quito Ecuador kindly placed flowers at the miraculous picture of The La Dolorosa and at the feet of the miraculous statue Our Lady of Good Success in petition of a successful surgery and recovery. As well as contacting three communities of Sisters to pray for Vern!

A dear friend shared with me that the evening before Vern’s surgery a Priest friend stopped by their home while traveling in the area. His day had been spent traveling and he needed to offer The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. In the past the Priest has ALWAYS had the Mass intention already spoken for, however this evening he had no intention! Our dear friends requested that the Mass intention be for Vern’s successful surgery that was to be the following morning.

In looking back over the last days and weeks of our lives, we see plainly the graces that were bestowed upon us. The night charge nurse in the ICU is a member of our Traditional Catholic Church, being in his care on the evening of surgery was surely a great blessing!

Another wonderful opportunity that comes with retirement is that Vern started attending Holy Mass on First Fridays. And once again, Our Lady of Sorrows would show Her servant her continued love and support. The First Friday of April was the Feast day of Our Lady of The Seven Sorrows. This Feast day always falls on the Friday proceeding Palm Sunday. Only this year it was as well First Friday, and the first day that Vern attended Holy Mass since his most successful surgery just 14 days earlier. Through your Holy Masses, Rosaries and continual prayer, Vern and I have received many-many graces over the past month. Our prayer for each of you is that Our Lady of Sorrows will reward you as she has rewarded Vern; her servant.

My “patient-patient” is doing very well, getting stronger by the day. His Doctor is pleased with his recovery so far, and cautions him not to do too much in the near future! THANK YOU ALL once again for the love, care, concerns and prayers that were offered in our behalf.

Fears of Cancer Allayed

My husband JPC had been a smoker for 30 years. A routine X-ray and follow up CAT- SCAN verified a mass on his upper left lung close to his shoulder. The 2 doctors did not see any mass on the three year old X-rays taken a few years back so must be cancer....

We asked for prayers. A 54-day Rosary Novena to Our Lady of Pompeii as well as a daily 9-novena to the Infant of Prague and Our Lady of Good Success (short novena). Our children were making a rosary and novena to Our Lady of Lourdes. We kept the daily Tridentine Mass and rosary even on hospital days. Intention of prayers: There is no sign of cancer, no need of surgery-biopsy; we were able to join planned pilgrimage to Fatima Lourdes etc.

PET SCAN, Brain MRI, Respiratory functions were done. All results were fine but not diagnostic. Surgery-biopsy still stands. Surgery had to be scheduled but JPC asked for and got repeat CAT SCAN just 6 weeks after the previous one (should be 12 weeks) I think the Blessed Mother had a hand in this.

The Miracle: Surgeon told us to finalize pilgrimage for there is no sign of cancer and no need for surgery-biopsy. The radiologist who studied three old X-rays, new S-ray, CAT – SCANS concluded that the same mass is found on each of the three old X-rays, new one and 2 CAT SCANS so it is NOT CANCER! The 2 doctors failed to see these.

We immediately went back to church for thanksgiving prayers for intention of everyone who prayed /still praying for us. They will always be in our daily prayers and masses MSC

P.S. Pray for the three –fold intentions in front of the Blessed Sacrament saying the hourly novena to OLOGS, I noticed a strong aroma of roses on the altar. It reminded me of the beautiful roses at the feet of Our Lady of Good Success in Quito Pilgrimage. Thank you so much Blessed Mother for the comfort, love, and sign of your help in our dire needs. We love you! We are leaving on a thanksgiving pilgrimage to Quito on Oct 25. We are remembering this apostolate in our prayers. God bless you-

Letter of Thanks from the Mother Prioress of our dear Carmelites of Carmen Alto in Quito

Praise Be Jesus Christ! How are you? We are trusting in the grace of God that you are well since your Carmelites are praying and petitioning for everything for you.

.Through this letter, I want to send our sincere gratitude for your help and collaboration in this critical moment we’ve been through with the sickness of our sisters. Sr. Maria Fanny sick with cancer has been treated in the hospital and has had to attend to certain debt of \$6,000. Therefore with this help [from the Apostolate] she has not had any difficulties in attending to this debt. As well, the debt increases with every examination and treatment. Sr Mercedes is sick with Septic Arteritis on the same leg that was almost amputated. Sr. Beatriz has a pulmonary malfunction so that she has to use oxygen daily. All of them in general offer up their pains, limitations and effort as a thankful offering to God and for all of you who have given us an opportune hand.

Thank you to the members of Our Lady of Good Success through their intervention we have been able to keep going. Tridentine Mass Altar dedicated to Our Lady of G.S. and the Child of Pichincha in Eastern Europe

Our Tridentine Altar is in our Kitchen Chapel. We have not the Holy Sacrament because a room cannot be separated from a kitchen nearby where I live and work. Above the Tabernacle, you see a framed picture composed from three pictures: Our Lady of Good Success, in the middle is Crucified Jesus [of Pichincha] I made this picture from a book of Dr. Horvat. I colored it myself so it doesn't have the right colors as it should have....On the right side is a picture of St Philomena. I proposed St Philomena to my faithful girls and women as a model of sanctity as I proposed Blessed Martyr Jose whose pictures are at the left and right side to my faithful boys and men to be their role model of courage and sanctity. On the very Altar are pictures of the Holy Face from the Shroud of Turin and of the Merciful Jesus. There is also a small picture of St Padre Pio and St Anne on the Tabernacle and two small statues of St. Michael the Archangel and St. Joseph. In the middle of them is a Cross with a small medal of the Sorrowful Immaculate Heart of Our Lady which is a memory of my grandmother. On the right side of the altar is a chest with a small statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe. In the battle of Lepanto in the year 1571 a big painting of Our Lady of Guadalupe was on the flagship of the Genoese Admiral, Giovanni Andrea Doria which Philip II of Spain had sent to him. And Philip II had received it from the Archbishop of Mexico. Before sending it he touched it to the original image. As you know Our Lady was victorious at this decisive battle for God's glory and for the immortal souls of Europe. Under the banner of Our Lady of Good Success now we are waging another decisive battle in this apocalyptic time....I pray for you and your family and the Apostolate every day!
